This form must be completed upon the return of the RV as a part of the RVshare checkout process.

Step 1 - Damage Walkthrough

The purpose of this walkthrough is to discover and record any damage that has occurred during the rental.

You must do a comprehensive review of the condition of the entire interior and exterior, which includes the undercarriage and roof, of the RV. Although you will have 72 hours to report damages to RVshare, it is in your best interest to discover any and all damage now so that the renter can sign off on it. **This will help to eliminate the possibility of a dispute.**
